- \* Place of Rescue I now has 250 children (17 of whom are babies), 24 Grannies, 25 AIDS patients and one pregnant girl waiting to have her baby.
- \* Place of Rescue II amazes us when we visit and see the abundant love for Jesus and for the children. One hundred children live there.
- \* All our children are learning to love and obey the Lord Jesus, to study hard in school, to relate to one another in love (well, most of the time!) In both Place of Rescue I and II the children love to praise God and to pray. They are growing up fast with the good nutrition and medical care they receive.
- \* Caring for so many children is not without problems. Last week a large amount of money was stolen from my wallet. We are praying for the Lord to reveal who took it. Join us to pray for a good resolution to this problem.
- \* We added grades 1 and 2 to our English program and added an extra hour of teaching for all. A generous donation enables us to forge ahead with teaching English. This has been very difficult as we lack qualified long term teachers. We are so grateful for volunteers who have been coming from Canada and for some local Cambodian teachers. Please pray that our English program might improve.



\* House of New Dreams our beautiful students dorm in Phnom Penh is finished and 7 young people are staying there, one learning sewing, three in high school and three in university.



Looking Ahead

- \* Place of Rescue III will be up and running soon. We have decided to purchase land now and begin to build as we have funds. Pastor Sopheap who will be the director is presently in contact with 32 children whom we are helping with rice and school supplies. Place of Rescue III will be built after the pattern of the other 2 orphanages with 10 homes built in a square with a green play area in the middle.
