Who's Helping Granny?

Have you ever wondered what a Seniors Home might be like in the developing world? Steve Ulrich & his eMiC team had an opportunity to find out this past June. The project was for **Reach One Touch One Ministries (ROТОМ)**,

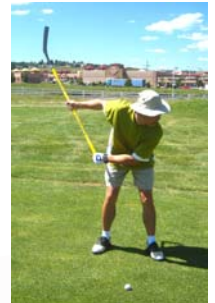
founded in 2003 by Kenneth Mugayehwenkyi after he met one elderly woman in Mukono, Uganda, and became aware of the difficulties she faced. Kenneth and his wife had been concerned about certain orphans, when they discovered that the orphans actually had a caregiver: this aging grandmother! As they began to look after her needs, they discovered many others who were also in desperate circumstances.

As is often the case in Africa, the "middle" generation is missing, dead from either Aids or war, leaving children and grandparents. There are no care programs for seniors, and any who do not have family members to care for them must survive on their own, living well below the poverty line. ROТОМ, with a small, very dedicated staff, now visits about 170 elderly in their homes and at seniors group meetings, providing fellowship, meals, medical and hygiene care, and even small home renovations when necessary.

ROТОМ now has land to create a **Seniors Care Center**. The eMiC team designed a group of 5 buildings to provide a health center, a hospice, an admin bldg and volunteer housing to help meet the needs of the aging population of Uganda.
