Pray for Haiti

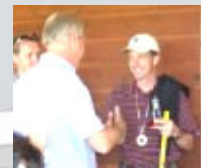


Steve joins a time of prayer in Haiti

As the poorest country in the western hemisphere, Haiti receives its share of attention by the media. Earlier this year it was the food riots, more recently, a series of hurricanes leaving hundreds dead. An abundance of missions organizations of all shapes and sizes minister to the poor, the sick, and the orphaned. But how do you break the strongholds in Haiti, a country that is entrenched in poverty, in voodoo, and in government corruption? Pastor Joseph, of the Doorway to Peace ministry, will tell you that it will take prayer—lots of prayer: “Haiti can never be reached in a true sense with the gospel of Jesus Christ until prayer saturates the villages, towns, cities and the nation”. His vision for a Prayer Centre atop a high mountain for people from all over Haiti (and around the world) to come and pray is one step closer to reality, after an eMi team came alongside him to design the Mount Zion Prayer Centre. The design incorporated the challenges of the unserved site—accessible only by goat path—including alternate energy and facilities for washrooms and cooking. eMi’s motto of “designing a world of hope” was never more appropriate as Haiti and its people face hopelessness every day. This prayer centre will play a major part in breaking the spiritual stronghold over Haiti.
