"This is not the end..."

If there was one repeated phrase that sustained our team during our week of work in Rwanda, this was it. When the ultimate task at hand is the spiritual and emotional reconstruction of a nation the road ahead can seem daunting, even impossible. At least by human standards. Today in the tiny country of Rwanda, 14 years after the genocide that killed over 800,000 people in just 100 days, true healing is still slow to come . . .

"... God is still writing His story."

On a sloping 3.5 acre site on the southeast outskirts of Kigali our eMi team was given the task of developing a master plan and designing the buildings for CentrePEACE Rwanda. The activities on this property will include counseling, vocational training for widows and single moms and community building programs to be held in its multi-purpose building and basketball court. Underlying all this will be the message that healing and reconciliation, whether of the body, mind or community must be undergirded by spiritual healing and reconciliation with God, through a saving faith in Jesus Christ . . .
