It was a pretty typical picture of a bunch of kids – not unlike the ones we take by the dozens on any eMi project trip. But Ralph, the director of one of our client ministries, had us look again. “The future president of Ethiopia might be in this photograph,” he said, “or the future secretary-general of the UN. Another Einstein or another Billy Graham”

Potential. Future. Hope. Powerful concepts made possible for these particular kids through the partnership between Engineering Ministries International and HopEthiopia. eMi was able to provide the design and technical expertise, allowing HopEthiopia to move forward in serving the children of Arbu Chulule.

Changing lives and changing futures. It's why you volunteer your time on an eMi project trip and donate your hard-earned dollars. It's why together we offer the gift of a good design to ministries around the world who are helping children and families step out of poverty and into a world of hope.

We don't always know what the impact of an eMi project will look like. A Children's Home in the Philippines designed by eMi in 2007 is now constructed and ready to take in orphans affected by Typhoon Haiyan. A school designed in Haiti in 2010 is preparing over 200 children each year for a better future and has been used as a hurricane shelter. A health

centre designed in Uganda in 2007 is providing specialized healthcare for the elderly and showing these seniors that their future, too, is valuable. A youth camp designed in Brazil in 2006 is now providing opportunities to build relationships with kids in the area. Not all those impacted by an eMi project will become president! But they will see the love of God demonstrated in a practical way that meets their needs.

This year eMi Canada sent out six project teams – and mobilized Canadian volunteers to a dozen additional projects led by our partner offices around the world. Dream with us about the lives and futures that will be changed because these ministries now have the resources to pursue their vision.
